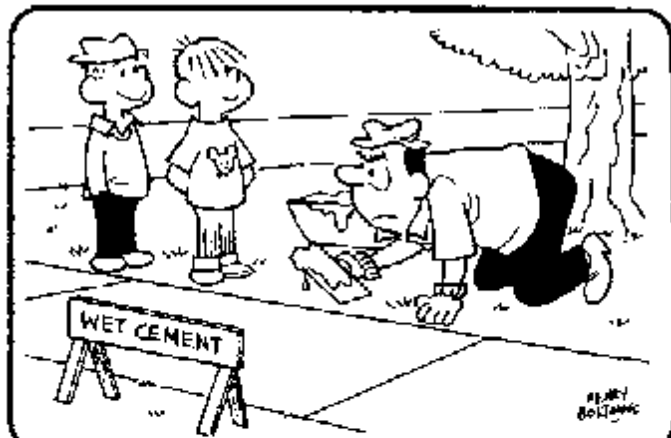
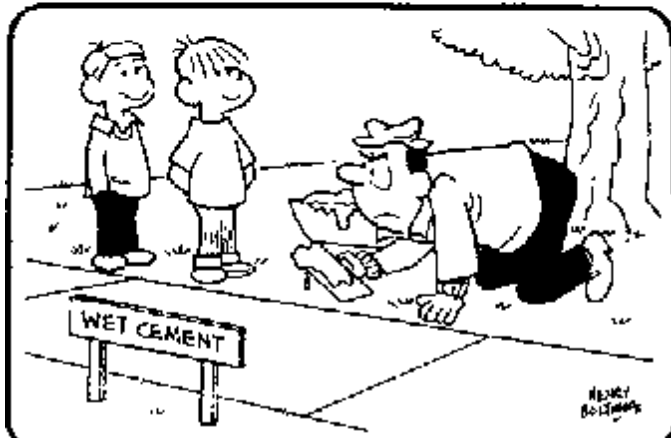

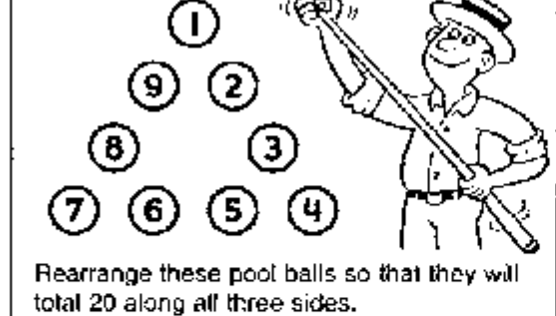


Find at least six differences in details between panels.

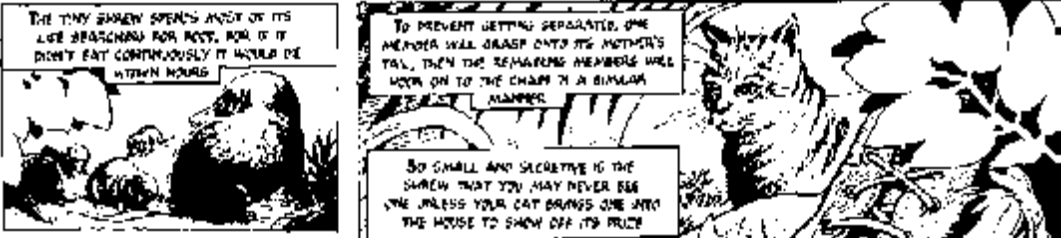
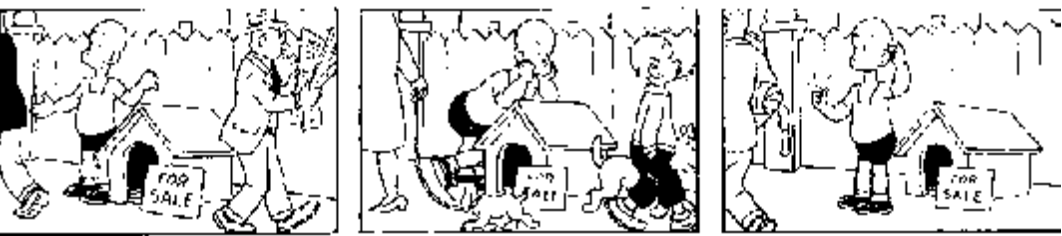
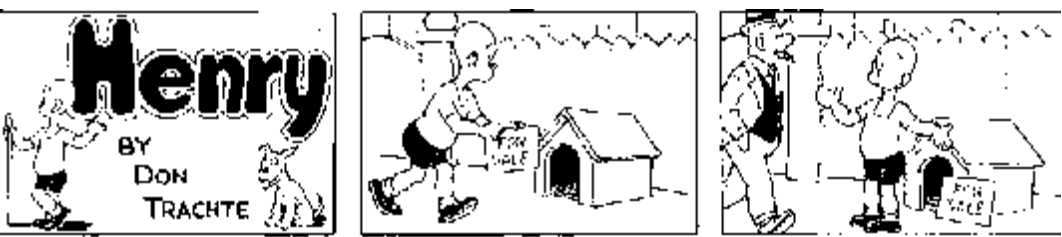
In the grid on the left, there is room for nine terms associated with the Internet. The following hints should help you navigate our web and lead you to the correct words.

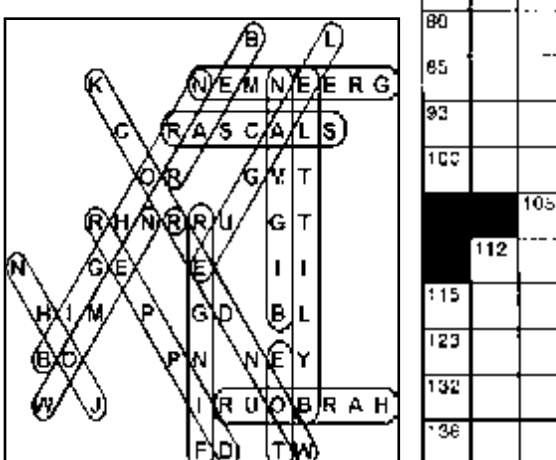

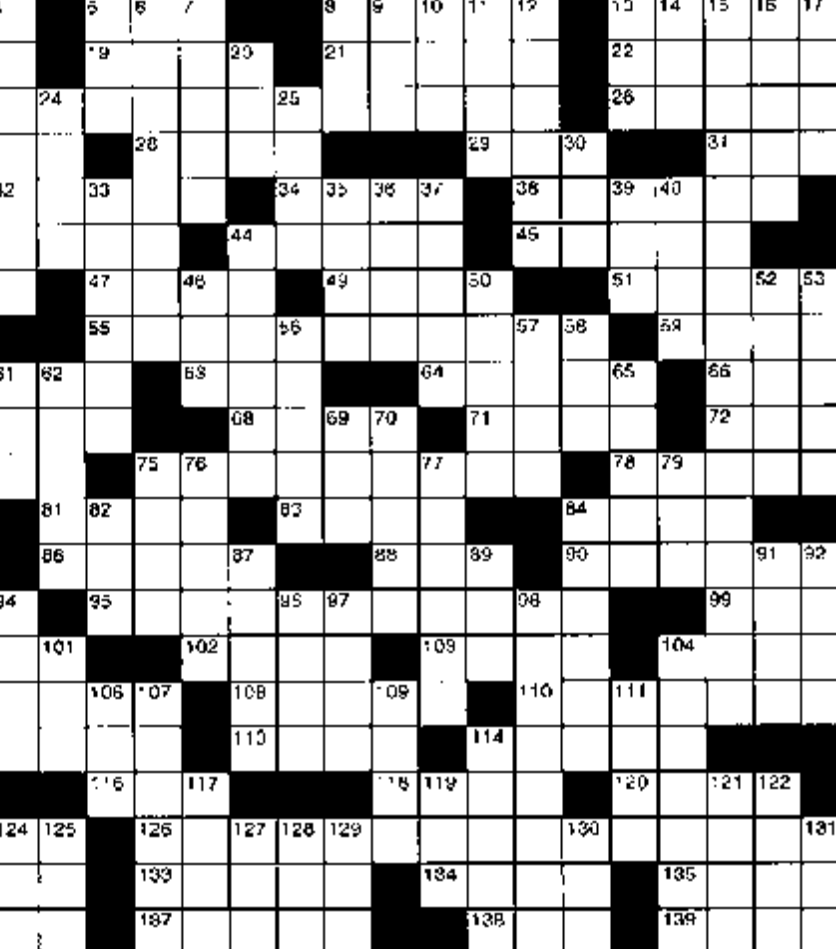
