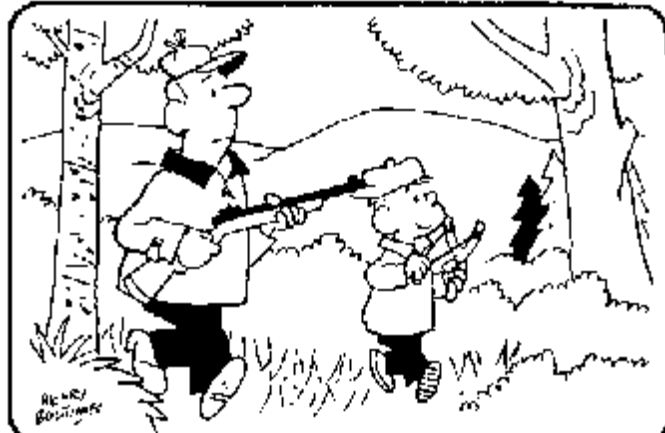

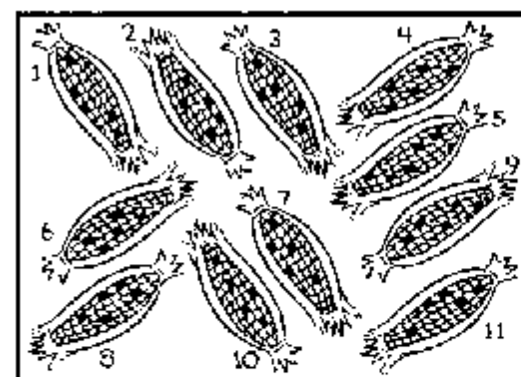

Find at least six differences in details between panels.



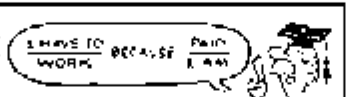

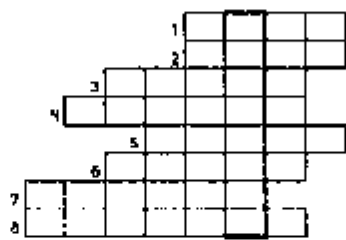

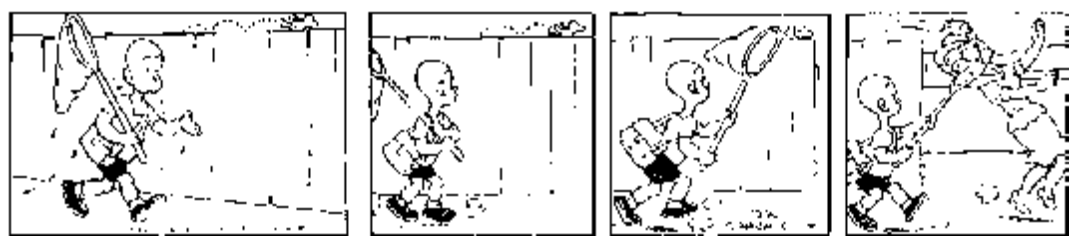
FALL IN THE COUNTRY!



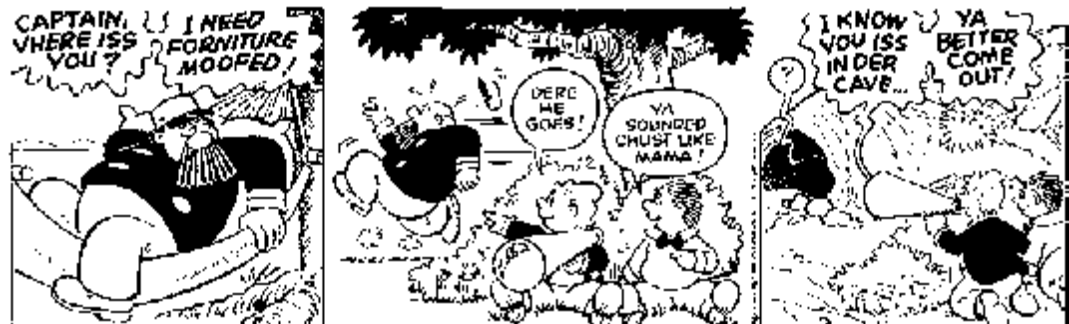
It's time for you to do your chores. In our grid there is room for eight words pertaining to this time of year. The following hints should help you celebrate the season.
