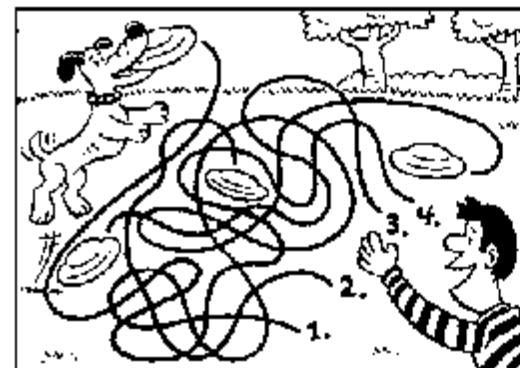

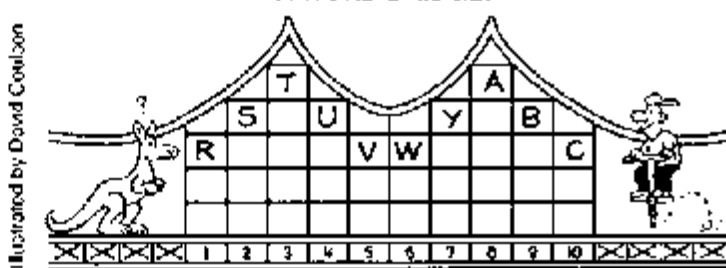

A WORD BRIDGE!



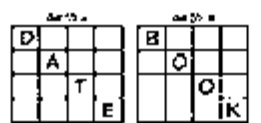

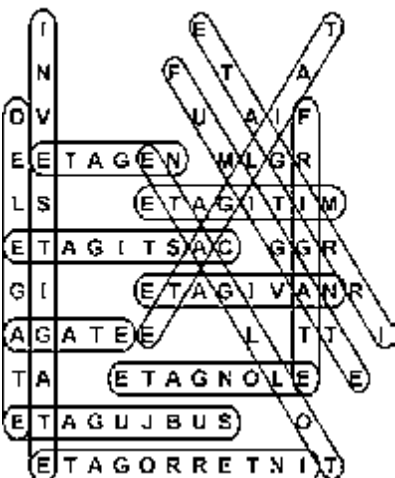
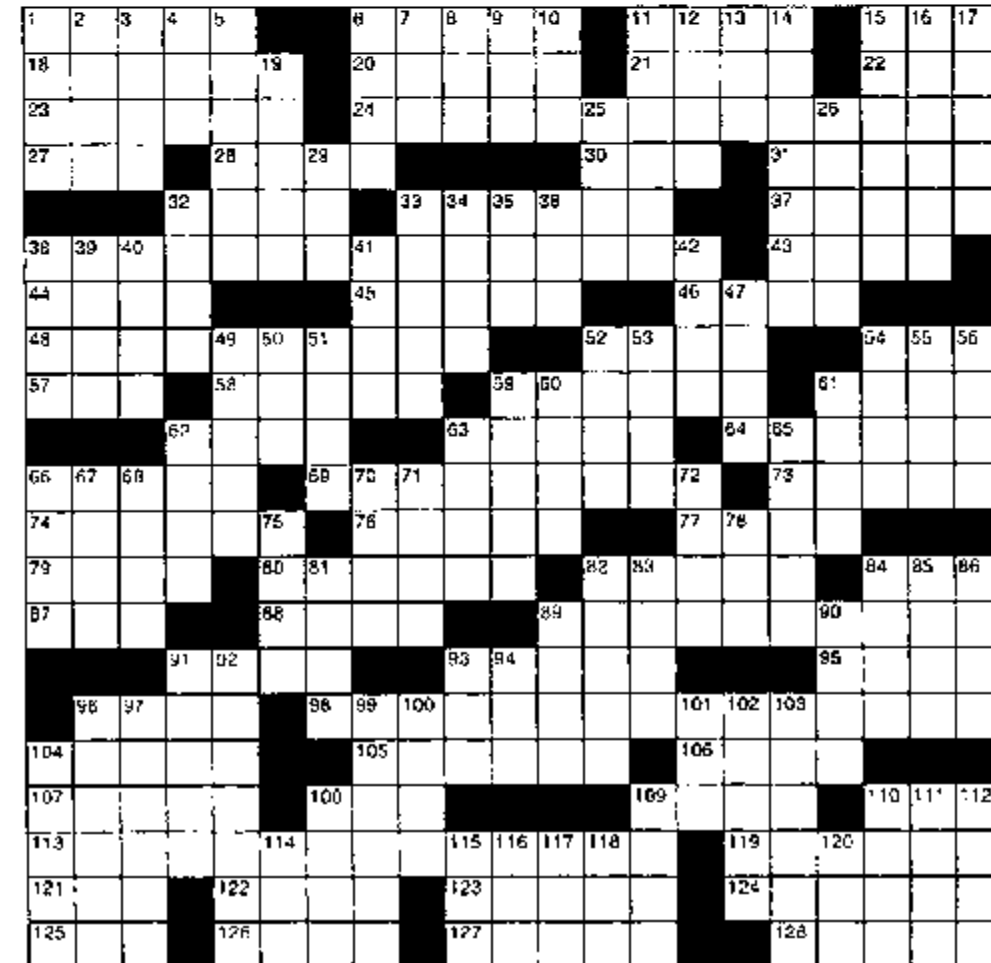
