A grid of letters for a word search puzzle. The letters are arranged in a grid with some words highlighted in a box.

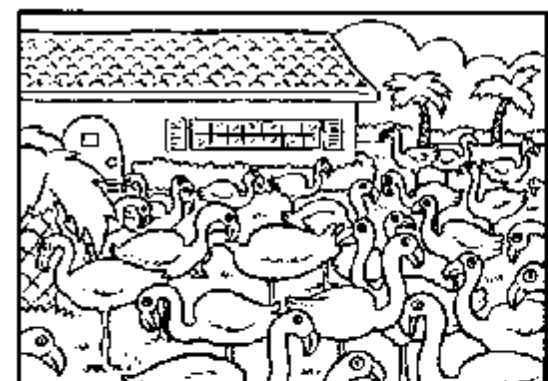
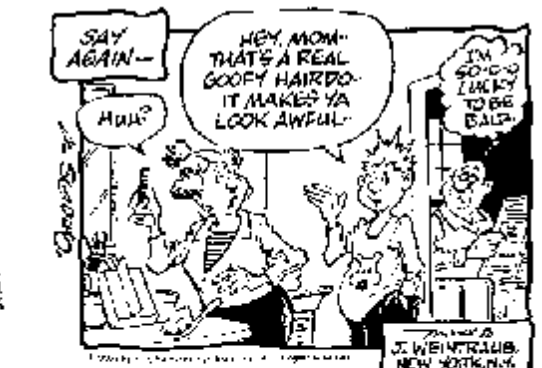
Find the listed words in the diagram. They run in all directions - forward, backward, up, down and diagonally.

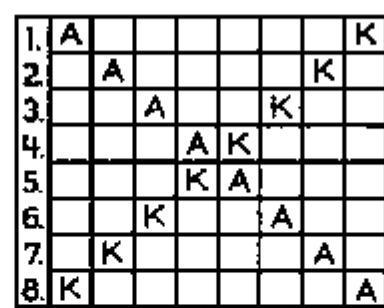

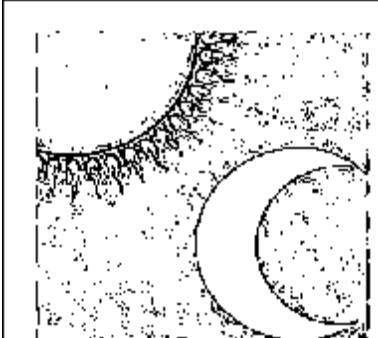

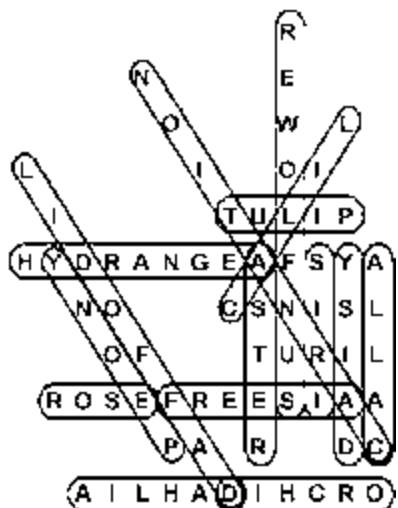
