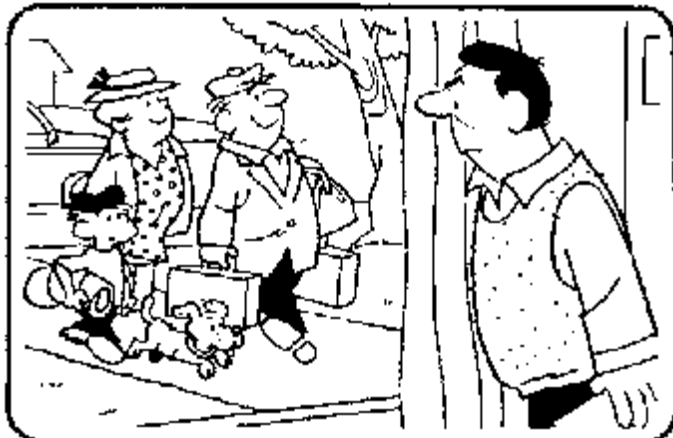


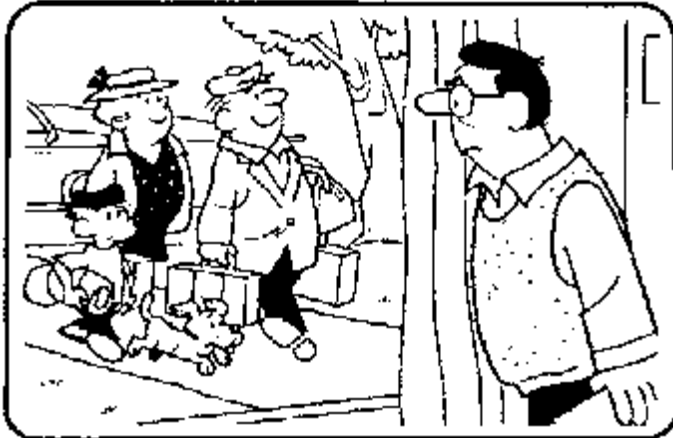

Find at least six differences in details between panels.

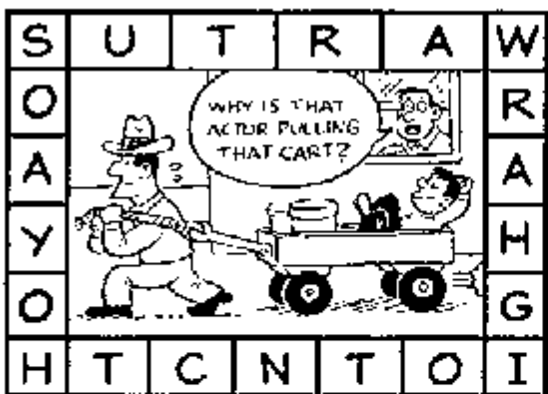

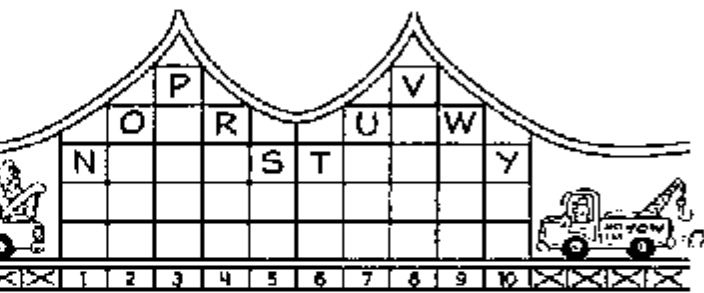
'AGE' WORDS! Find the following words that end with 'age.'
